

### **This week in Ock Class – w/e 13<sup>th</sup> May**

This week in maths we have been coming to the end of our unit on Decimals. We have focused on adding and subtracting Decimals, linking to when we might need to do this in real life situations. We made lots of connections with using the column method; however, we have had to work hard on ensuring that the digits are in the right columns, particularly when there are different numbers of decimal places.

In our English this week we have continued with our sentence stacking lessons in which we have been writing a Biography about Sir David Attenborough. This is a topic that many of us are passionate about and we have really been enjoying lots about such an inspirational person!

We have learnt lots about the Ancient Greeks this week as both our Topic lesson and our Art lesson were linked this period of History. In our Art lessons, we learnt about Ancient Greek mosaics. We thought about how they were made, and what they told us about life in Ancient Greece. We then designed our own mosaics and we will be making them next week. In our Topic lesson, we learnt about daily life in Ancient Greece in more detail. We made research posters with our partner about Ancient Greek homes, jobs and clothes.

In PE we spent one of our lessons focusing on our Orienteering skills. We worked in small groups to write a set of instructions, based on directions; we gave these instructions to another group and they had to see if the instructions were accurate in leading them to the end position. In our PE lesson with Mrs Ballard we have continued to practise our Rounders skills.
