

Use of Sports Premium Funding for 2020-2021

This year, schools have received PE and Sport Funding. This funding must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and Sport, for the benefit of primary aged children, in the 2020-2021 academic year so that they are encouraged to develop healthy, active lifestyles. The exact amount of money that we will receive is £17,640 (based on £16,000 and £10 per pupil in years 1-6).

There was also £1, 662.85 of funding carried forward from 2019-2020 (due to lockdown). We have used and will be using this money to pay for new equipment including new basketball posts and archery sets for our Interhouse competitions.
