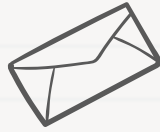

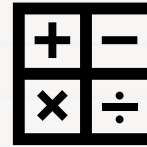

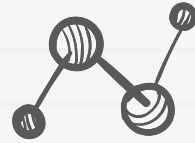
Maths



Multiplication and Division

This week we practiced using the partitioning method for multiplication. We partitioned the 2-digit number (the multiplier) into tens and ones, and then we multiplied these by the 1-digit number (the multiplicand). To finish we added these two answers together to complete our multiplication. Well done Year 3 for being great Bounce Back Bunnies and for persevering throughout this week.

Science

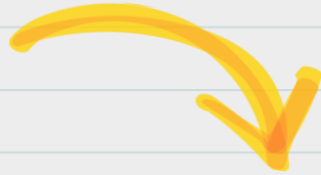


Plants
