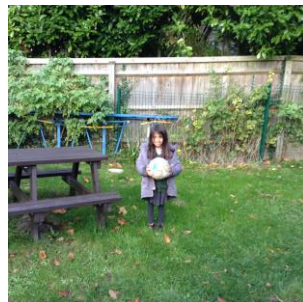


Weekly update 19.11.21
