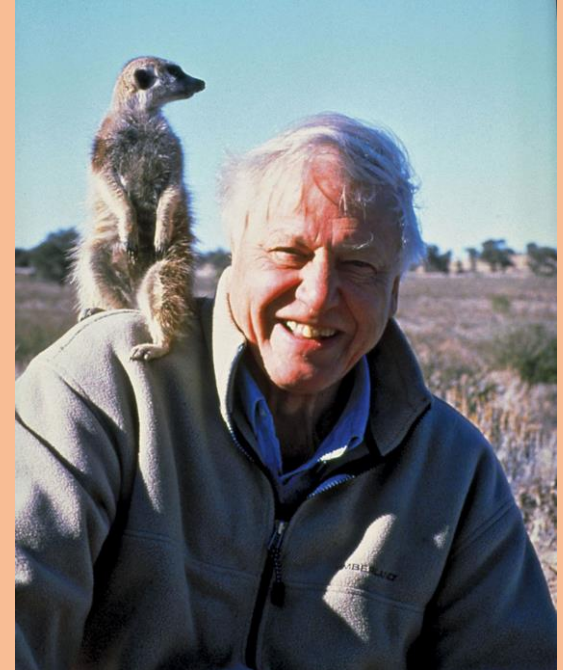
Maths

English

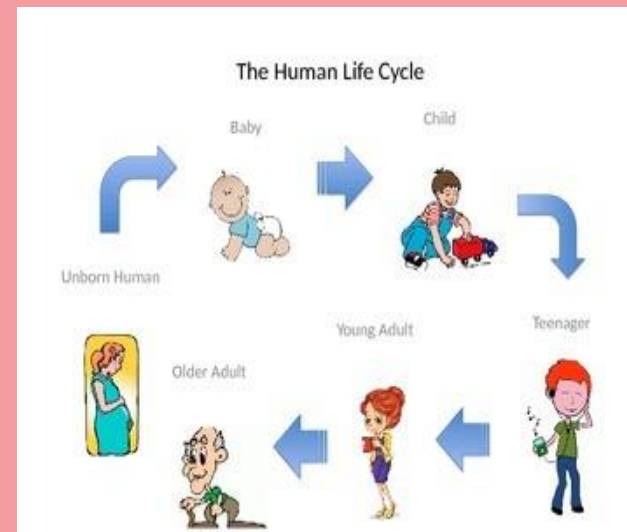
