This week in maths we have been continuing our work on multiplication and division by looking at different written methods of multiplication and multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers.

In English, we have been really impressed with the children's ideas in their sentence stacking of The Lost Thing. Our handwriting focus has been the letter k.

In Geography we started our new Topic of Brazil and have been getting acquainted with where Brazil is located and finding out more about it. In Science, we have begun our new topic of Electricity by thinking about what we already know and what we would like to know about electricity.

This week's spelling homework is on words with the suffix -ous. We have also been recapping the 'ee' sound using the digraphs ee, ea and e-e.

In RE we have been thinking about the difference between a pilgrimage and a holiday. We have begun our new term's computing lessons finding out about the internet and how it works. In Spanish we have been learning how to ask *¿Cómo te llamas?* and how to respond.

There is an extra small piece of homework this week for Science. Please can you count the number of plug sockets in each room of your house and report back for next week when we will be thinking about which room in the house has the most sockets. Please also keep up with practising spellings, times tables and reading.
